User Manual

BACKGROUND

The e-GDDS (Enhanced General Data Dissemination System) is an evolutionary system reflecting changing needs of data users over time. The e-GDDS was approved by the IMF's Executive Board on July 1, 2015, following the Ninth Review of the Fund's Data Standards Initiatives. The new e-GDDS Legal Text supersedes the existing rules governing the GDDS. Individual country presentations reflect the current features of the e-GDDS.

IMF proposed participating countries of e-GDDS to host and manage their National Data Summary Page (NSDP) within their Open Data Platform (ODP). The scope of the manual is to provide step by step instructions in managing NSDP by the business users such as e-GDDS coordinator without much technical knowledge/support.

NATIONAL SUMMARY DATA PAGE (NSDP)

The NSDP hosted on an ODP provides quick access to country's economic and financial data consistent with the e-GDDS data categories.

The NSDP can be accessed by using the '**NSDP**' menu item which appears on the top navigation bar of a host agency's Open Data Platform (ODP). It may look like below screen:



Note: The NSDP is a live page that can be accessed by any users depending on the host agency's ODP settings. If the ODP is set to Public, all users can access the NSDP without login. However, if the ODP is set to Private, users must login to ODP to access the NSDP.

The NSDP consists of three groupings:

1. Macroeconomic and Financial Data
2. Macroeconomic and Financial Data : Encouraged Data
3. Demographic and Selected Socio-Economic Indicators

Under each grouping, there are several data categories defined as per e-GDDS standards and for each of these data categories users can get the relevant data and metadata using the following buttons:

- **Browse Data** – links to human readable data usually from ODP
- **Download in SDMX** – links to data in SDMX format
- **DSBB Metadata** – links to access Dissemination Standards Bulletin Board (DSBB) metadata information available on IMF DSBB website.

The complete list of data categories that are included in e-GDDS are provided in the next page for reference.


NSDP EDITOR PAGE

Users with Administrative rights to the hosting ODP can edit the NSDP using the **'Edit page'** option. The **'Edit page'** option appears on the upper right side as shown in below screenshot.

EDITING THE NSDP

Managers of the NSDP hosting ODP portal can configure the links to “Browse Data”, “Download in SDMX” and “DSBB Metadata” using the ‘Edit’ link next to each data category in the NSDP Editor page.

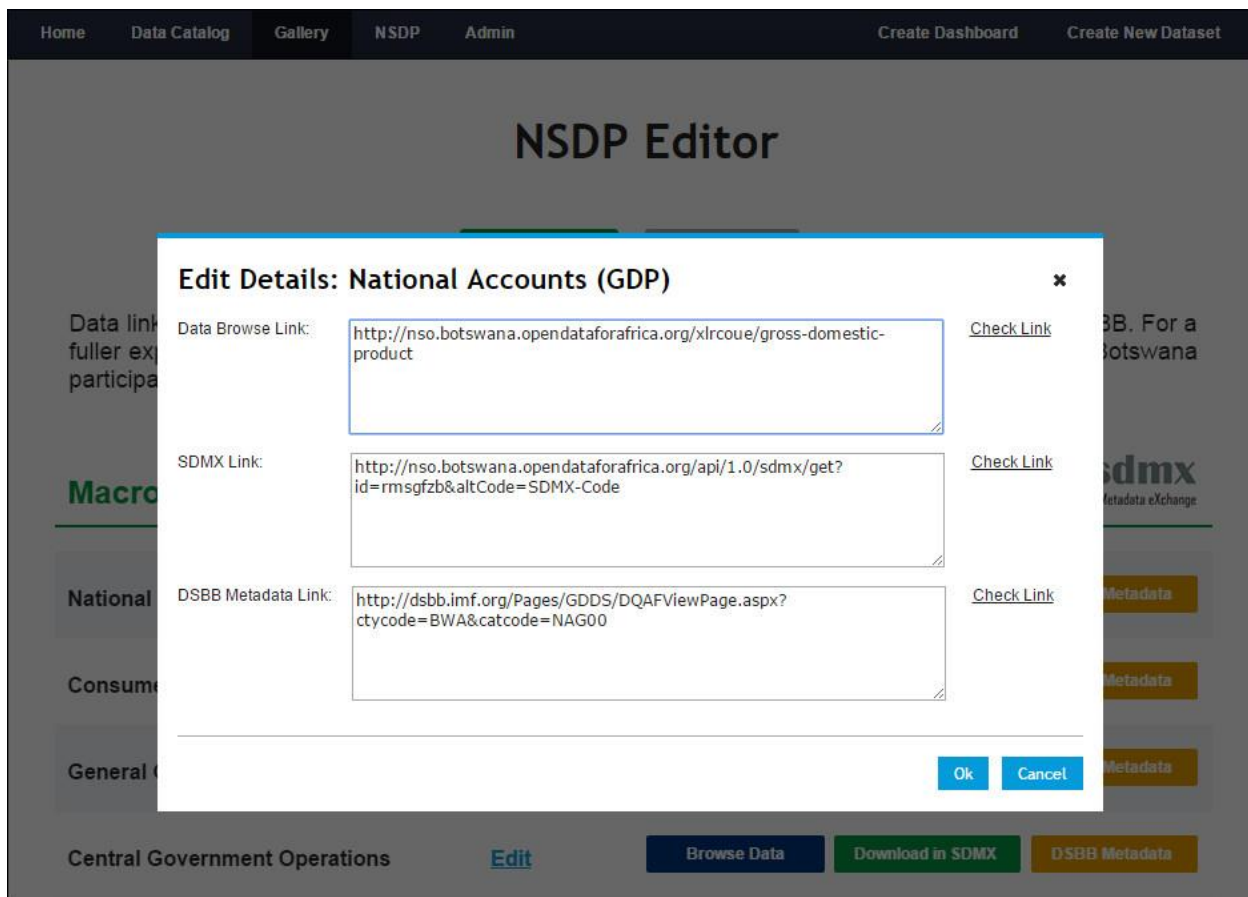

By clicking on the ‘Edit’ option, a pop-up window will be launched displaying the links currently configured for each of the buttons as shown in the next screenshot.



The links can be updated using the input box given:

- **Data Browse Link** – a link to any dashboard representing the data category from the respective agency’s ODP.
- **SDMX Link** – refer to the section [Steps to generate SDMX link](#) to get the SDMX downloadable link from ODP.
- **DSBB Metadata Link** – this should be a link to the DSBB metadata page hosted on IMF DSBB website (<http://dsbb.imf.org/>). Refer to the section [“DSBB Metadata Link”](#) for more details.

Note: IMF staff has pre-populated the NSDP links.

While configuring the links for each button, links can be verified instantly by using the **“Check Link”** option next to the input box. By clicking on **“Check Link”**, the link specified in the respective input box will open in a new browser window where the content can be verified.

The changes can be saved using the 'OK' button. The steps can be repeated for other data categories which may require an edit.

Note: If any link is not available for any data category, it can be left blank. By leaving it as blank, the corresponding button for that particular data category will be hidden. In the below example, "Download in SDMX" link has been left blank for the "Central Government Operations" and the screen may look like:

The changes made are stored temporarily within the NSDP Editor. By clicking the **'Publish'** button, changes stored in the Editor will get published to live NSDP.

The **'Cancel'** button helps to abort the changes made using the Editor.

GENERATING SDMX AND METADATA LINKS

STEPS TO GENERATE SDMX LINK:

SDMX links can be generated within ODP using standard syntax as below and the relevant dataset ID code. For ex, National Accounts (GDP) dataset is chosen here.

The standard SDMX link syntax to be used in NSDP is:

`http://[Agency ODP URL]/api/1.0/sdmx/get?id=[Dataset ID]&altCode=SDMX-Code`

To get the Dataset ID, open the relevant dataset and get the ID as below example.



In this example, for Exchange Rates category, the final SDMX URL to be configured in Botswana's NSDP will be:

THE DSBB METADATA LINK:

The metadata for each category will be available in the IMF Dissemination Standards Bulletin Board portal (<http://dsbb.imf.org/>). To obtain the metadata links to be configured for each category, click on e-GDDS section in the left side menu in the DSBB website, click on the country link under Metadata as shown below and select the country.
